# CALL FOR PAPERS

## Forest School Conference 2011

Saturday 8th October at PGL Liddington, nr Swindon

### Academic Papers:

The IOL Forest School Conference would like to offer practitioners, emerging researchers and experienced researchers the chance to share their research in two sessions at the conference, giving space for approximately eight papers. These will be peer-reviewed by two academics from Anglia Ruskin University under the guidance of Professor Theodora Papatheodorou, the Professor of Research from the Faculty of Education, and we will seek to publish the papers after the conference.

### The time-scales will be as follows:

1. **April/May 2011:** Call for abstracts: to be submitted by June 3rd to Sara Knight, Faculty of Education, Anglia Ruskin University, Bishop Hall Lane, Chelmsford, CM11SQ. Submission indicates a willingness to complete the writing of the paper.
2. **End of June:** feedback to be sent to contributors. Acceptance indicates a willingness to review the paper.
3. **2nd September:** date for the receipt of completed papers (up to 2000 words not including references)
4. **End of September:** feedback to be sent to contributors
5. **8th October:** Contributors will have 15 minutes to present their findings and take questions
6. After the conference contributors will be given the opportunity to make final adjustments to their papers prior to publication once we have confirmation of the requirements of the publisher.

### Call for Paper Abstracts:

300 words maximum to address the following headings, which will form the criteria for the initial review:

- Title:
- Background – why did you carry out this study:
- Research questions:
- What do we know about this already (relationship to previous studies by others and self);
- Theoretical and conceptual framework of research;
- Ethical Considerations;
- How did you find things out (methodology and methods);
- What did you find out (main finding or discussion);
- What are the implications for practice or policy;
